

Resource Conservation District of Monterey County:
Salinas River Flood Risk Reduction and Habitat Improvement Project



Project will implement three new secondary channel vegetation and sediment management (totaling 15 acres), along with removal of the invasive giant reed, *Arundo Donax*, for flood risk reduction and habitat improvement. Secondary channels are typically 0.25-0.75 miles long and connect with the main stem of the river at their upstream and downstream ends.
